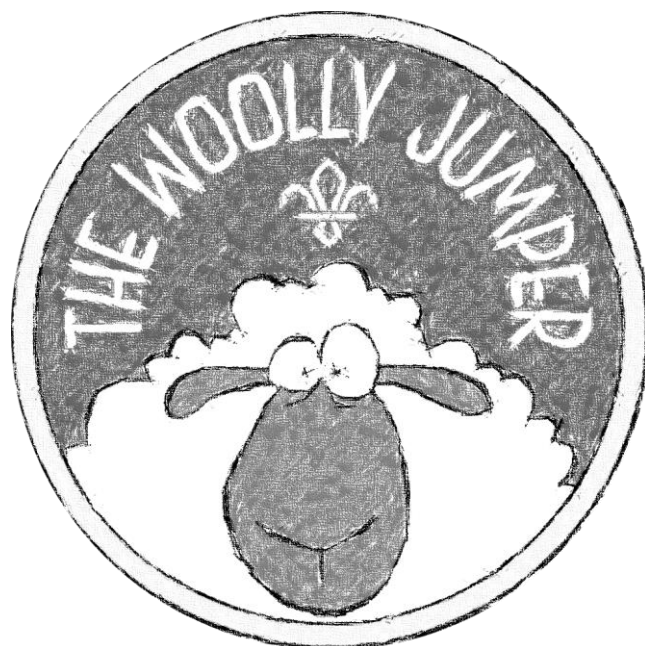

It is YOUR code of Conduct...

As a group, we need you to produce the participant code of conduct for Woolly Jumper 2019.

In small groups, have a think about the values of Scouting:

- **Respect**
 - We have self-respect and respect for others.
- **Integrity**
 - We act with integrity; we are honest, trustworthy and loyal.
- **Care**
 - We support others and take care of the world in which we live.
- **Belief**
 - We explorer our faiths, beliefs and attitudes.
- **Cooperation**
 - We make positive difference; we cooperate with others and make friends.

Using these values, have a think about and make a list of appropriate and inappropriate behaviour, peoples actions and how we would want other participants to act.

Breaking the Rules...
